The Line Diagnostics Platform allows single-ended 30 MHz spectral analysis, pre-qualification, and TDR troubleshooting as well as dual-ended outside plant, in-home and rate reduction analysis, and provides historical test comparisons for service planning and proactive maintenance. A demonstration of the functionality and performance of the Line Diagnostics Platform will be a centerpiece of Aware's booth at the show. Aware also recently announced a reseller agreement for the Line Diagnostics Platform with Occam Networks.
